Executive Director Kim Vickers,

A police officer with the Fort Worth Police Department, Douglas Campbell TCLOLE # [REDACTED] (DOB [REDACTED]) was terminated on December 23, 2013. Please see attached paperwork for confirmation of his termination. On September 26, 2016, Arlington Police Officer J. Heisel conducted a traffic stop on Mr. Campbell's vehicle. During that traffic stop, Officer Heisel received a warrant hit on Mr. Campbell's license plate. Mr. Campbell indicated to Officer Heisel that he was an active police officer and those warrants were taken care of and it was a mistake in the system. He showed Officer Heisel his TCLOLE license to validate his claim. Officer Heisel relied on this display of information and released Mr. Campbell with a speeding ticket. Officer Heisel thought the interaction was inconsistent with a police officer and called the Fort Worth Police Department to verify Mr. Campbell's status as a police officer. Upon contacting Fort Worth PD, Officer Heisel was informed of Mr. Campbell's termination and subsequently charged Douglas Campbell with impersonating a police officer.

As a part of a plea bargain in this case, the Tarrant County District Attorney's Office is requiring Mr. Campbell to permanently surrender his license. His plea was completed on November 28, 2017 and I've attached the notarized Permanent Surrender of License and respectfully request that Mr. Campbell's license be permanently surrendered as a result of his actions.

# Texas Administrative Code

**TITLE 37** PUBLIC SAFETY AND CORRECTIONS  
**PART 7** TEXAS COMMISSION ON LAW ENFORCEMENT  
**CHAPTER 223** ENFORCEMENT  
**RULE §223.13** Surrender of License

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- (a) A licensee may surrender a license:
- (1) as part of an employee termination agreement;
  - (2) as part of a plea bargain to a criminal charge;
  - (3) as part of an agreed settlement to commission action; or
  - (4) for any other reason.
- (b) A license may be surrendered either permanently or for a stated term.
- (c) Effective dates:
- (1) the beginning date for any surrender shall be the date stated in the request or, if none, the date it was received by the commission;
  - (2) a term surrender shall have its ending date stated in the request; and
  - (3) any request without a stated ending date shall be construed as a permanent surrender.
- (d) A licensee may surrender any license by sending, or causing to be sent, a signed, notarized, written request to the executive director, who may accept or reject the request. The signed written request shall indicate that the licensee understands and has knowledge of the consequences of the document being signed. The executive director may accept requests for surrender submitted to the commission in any other form that indicates the licensee intends to surrender the license to the commission. The executive director may liberally construe the intent of any request. The surrender of one commission-issued license operates as a surrender of all commission-issued licenses. The surrender should include a summary of the reason for the surrender.
- (e) If accepted, the licensee is no longer licensed:
- (1) effective on the beginning date of the surrender; and
  - (2) except for permanent surrenders, until such person applies for and meets the requirements of a new license.
- (f) The effective date of this section is February 1, 2014.
